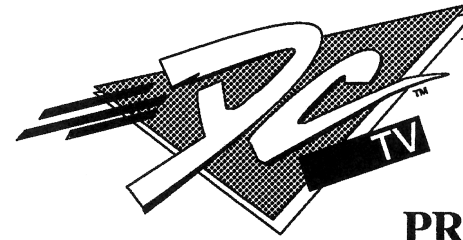

VER 1.1 HARD DISK INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS, PROGRAM CHANGES, ADDENDUM, ERRATA, and CREDITS

HARD DISK INSTALLATION

DCTV Ver. 1.1 has an easy to use hard disk installation utility - *The Amiga Application Installation Utility* from Commodore - on both Disk #1 (Normal DCTV) and Disk #2 (Low memory DCTV).

Double click on either the Disk 1 or Disk 2 icon. Find the icon named "Install" and double click. This will present you with the Install welcome screen.

Once you are in the Install program, follow the on screen instructions. If you have problems or want to know more about the different options, there is online Help available.

Install has three different modes available to install DCTV.

NOVICE - All actions automatic

INTERMEDIATE USER - Limited manual control

EXPERT USER - Must confirm all actions

If you are in doubt as to which to use, use the NOVICE option. Or you may "try" Intermediate mode or Expert mode by using the "pretend" option.

Install will place all necessary files on your hard disk. Optional files such as the DCTV tools from disk 1, or sample pictures, palettes, and files used by the tutorial from disk 3 and 4 will need to be installed on your hard disk by dragging the icons to your hard disk.

Here is a detailed listing of the install options.

Install options

NOVICE - No options - Creates new directory called DCTV on largest available hard disk partition. Automatically copies DCTV program and support directory - DCTVData - and files to it. Install system files for OS 1.3. Copies file SetPatchMrgCop to C:. Writes to S:user-startup.

The following options, Installation and Log Options, are for both Intermediated and Expert.

NTSC/PAL NOTES

References to NTSC or PAL are made only when the information is pertinent to that format only. References that include both video formats are referred to as video or composite video.

All aspects of the DCTV hardware/software are the same with following exceptions for PAL:

There is no Tint Adjust

Digitize and Process page - There is no video SOURCE (camera or tape) option

All screen shots in the manual are from the NTSC version, therefore the aspect ratio will differ for PAL screens.

ADDENDUM - Additional changes and features

DCTV

Clear & Wipe buttons and keys now affect stencil in Make Stencil mode

Pattern & Warp fill now work in Make Stencil mode

TOOLNAME=<tool> - If present, all icons written by DCTV will have <tool> as the default tool. If not present, it uses the path name of program.

For example:

Work:DCTV/DCTV

Maximum Font size is 160

IFFtoDCTV & DISP

Now support wild cards under Amiga OS 2.0

IFFtoDCTV

-v option does not work under Amiga OS 1.3.

Under OS 2.0 requires the appropriate monitor (program) installed.
